Gingerbread Pecans Celebrate a sweet taste of the season with this festive snack. Ingredients: • 1 large egg white, beaten • 2 cups raw pecan halves • 2 tablespoons granulated sugar • 2 tablespoons light brown sugar • 2 teaspoons gingerbread spice blend • 1 pinch salt Directions: Preheat oven to 300° F. Line baking sheet with parchment paper and set aside. In a large bowl, whisk beaten egg white with a fork until frothy. Add pecans and stir until coated. Sprinkle pecans with granulated sugar, brown sugar, gingerbread spice and salt. Stir to coat evenly. Spread pecans in an even layer on the prepared baking sheet. Bake pecans for 40 minutes, stirring halfway. Allow pecans to cool completely before serving.
